These programs are ideal for self-directed, individual training sessions. The student has full navigational control. Both English and Spanish versions are available for most truck-specific programs.



Main Program Menu




Interactive quiz with post-quiz review capabilities



A key benefit of DP operator training is that the trainer has more flexibility to focus on the needs of the individual learner. While some students may still be working on the classroom portion of the training, the trainer can move those who are ready on to the practical hands-on portion. Students can each learn at their own pace rather than requiring the entire class to learn at the same pace, resulting in each student learning more effectively.

The trainer is also able to focus on the hands-on portion of the training without having to switch back and forth between classroom and hands-on as trainees are ready to move on.


By empowering each trainee with the ability to complete training at a pace that is consistent with their experience, they may move more efficiently through the training process as individuals rather than members of a larger training group.

Some trainees may complete their training earlier than scheduled and can move immediately into on the job training. That means your operators can become productive in their roles even earlier while still benefiting from the proven effectiveness of Crown's Demonstrated Performance training.

What is the cost of this product?

Like many other licensed software solutions, the cost is based on the number of students (licenses) that require access to the training. Crown currently offers two options: integrating the training assets into the customer's LMS or providing access to the customer's employees using Crown's LMS.

How can I be sure this product will work well with our internal systems?

A free and fully functional but shortened demo dispatch file version of the product is available from your Crown dealer. The demo program can be installed and tested on your intended host system.

The Demo dispatch file contains a SCORM 1.2 compliant LMS version for testing with your LMS system. Other output options are available.

If functional changes are needed, Crown will work with you directly to determine if the changes can be accommodated and, if so, create a custom output to address your needs.
